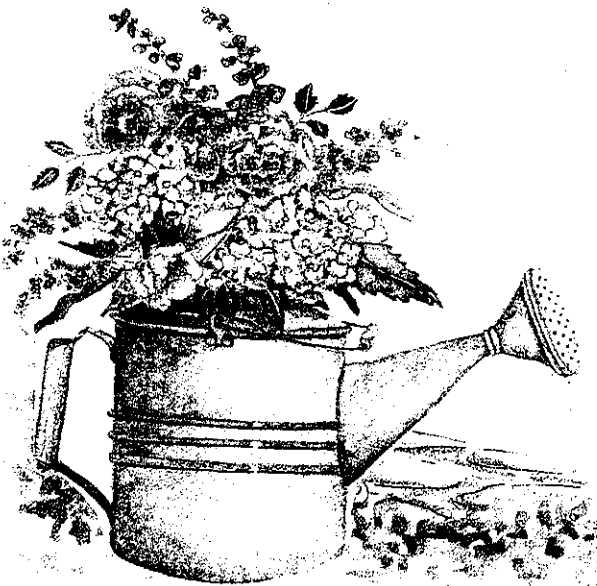

**GARDEN # 3**

The Gardens of David and Janet Janson

This stop will take you through the basics of transforming your yard into a low-maintenance, high interest oasis that will withstand Cincinnati's sometimes dry and, very hot summers. The bones of this mainly, hillside garden utilize rock in a variety of ways. Walls are constructed of flat limestone while terraces are formed with large angular limestone sections to mimic the kinds of rock outcroppings seen along Ohio's highways. Plantings are patterned after alpine settings and Mediterranean-style gardens to soften and add interest to the rocks while other areas of the yard offer more traditional plantings such as hosta, junipers, and boxwood. The garden features a large pond-less waterfall and a rustic pergola made of recycled elm trees. This garden is a 2005 Cincinnati Horticultural Society's Gardener's Recognition Award Winner.
